

The Town Board of Grenville, SD met on April 30, 2026 at 7:00 pm. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Herrick. Roll call was taken and present were, Leon Herrick, Kellen Lesnar, Scott Rudningen and Finance Officer, Donna Herrick. The Pledge of Allegiance was said. The minutes of the March meeting were read by D Herrick. A motion to approve them made by Rudningen, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Lesnar. The finance officer report was given by D Herrick. Lesnar made a motion to approve the finance officer report and Rudningen seconded the motion.

Old Business: The status of citywide cleanup was given. One bid was received for road grading for town roads by Colin Johnson for \$110 per hour. L Herrick made a motion to accept the bid; Lesnar seconded the motion. A resident asked for an update on the sewer line shared by the Longbranch and Post Office. Herrick told the resident that there has been no word from the owner of the post office regarding what had been decided about the sewer line. Herrick also said that J Pearson will be contacted about completing the graveling of town roads.

New Business: The finance officer let the board know that the town website is functional and also that residents had been notified with water bills of the website address. No building permits were issued this month.

Public Open Forum: A resident asked if there will be bids for tree removal this summer. They were told that the town was waiting to see if the town is awarded a grant by the Forestry Department. A resident asked if the town had received a dividend from Venture Communication. The resident was told that no dividend had been received at the time of the meeting.

A motion was made by Herrick to adjourn the meeting and seconded by Rudningen.
