

The Town Board of Grenville, SD met on June 25, 2026 at 7:00 pm. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Herrick. Roll call was taken and present were, Leon Herrick, Kellen Lesnar, Scott Rudningen and Finance Officer, Donna Herrick. The Pledge of Allegiance was said. The minutes of the March meeting were read by D Herrick. A motion to approve them made by Lesnar, 2nd by Rudningen. The finance officer report was given by D Herrick. Rudningen made a motion to approve the finance officer report and Lesnar seconded the motion.

Warrants were read by Lesnar. Web Water (\$1484.61). OtterTail (\$519.73). K Lesnar (\$64.65 - 1 meeting). L Herrick (\$110.82 - 1 meeting, water turn on, curb stop issue, conversation with GF&P and sheriff about a complaint). S Rudningen (\$64.64 – 1 meeting). J Carlson (\$230.87 - water testing). D Herrick (\$831.15 – finance officer). Dept of Health Water Testing (\$20.00). Venture (\$139.95 – June Bill). Reporter & Farmer (\$51.24 – publishing). Langager Stack Movers & Roll-Off (\$1456.28 – 2 containers, milage, & disposal). Mike's Heating & Cooling (\$7107.15 - carrier air conditioner & coil for Longbranch, labor). DNAR (\$80.00 – yearly environmental fees). A motion was made by Rudningen to approve the warrants and this was seconded by Lesnar.

Old Business: The air conditioning unit in the Longbranch was replaced and is working well.

New Business: No building permits were issued this month. There was a complaint made by a resident that another resident was dumping fish remains on the west side of town and not covering them up which causes an offensive smell which permeated the neighborhood. The responsible resident was at the meeting and told by the board that they must cover these remains or they would be fined. Another complaint was made about a resident who was building an addition to their house but had not put a foundation under the addition. The chairman has spoken to the resident on this matter. There will be a community potluck picnic at the park on August 22nd at 1 pm. The picnic will be open to all residents in the Grenville area.

Public Open Forum: A resident answered a complaint from last month about the lack of mowing by the elevator on the west side of town. They read what they claimed to be the result of a court case from many years ago but could not give the board exact dates so this information could not be verified. A resident complained that during a water main repair that their mailbox had been damaged. The chairman agreed that the town would look into the matter. A resident asked when the town would spray for mosquitos and was told that the chairman would call and get the town on the list for spraying.

A motion was made by Herrick to adjourn the meeting and seconded by Lesnar.
