

The Town Board of Grenville, SD met on March 26, 2026 at 7:00 pm. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Herrick. Roll call was taken and present were, Leon Herrick, Kellen Lesnar, Scott Rudningen and Finance Officer, Donna Herrick. The Pledge of Allegiance was said. The minutes of the February meeting were read by D Herrick. A motion to approve them made by Lesnar, 2nd by Rudningen. The finance officer report was given by D Herrick. Rudningen made a motion to approve the finance officer report and Lesnar seconded the motion.

Warrants were read by Lesnar. Web Water (\$1268.79). OtterTail (\$489.82). K Lesnar (\$92.35 - 1 meeting, notify residents of water shutoff). D Herrick (\$935.04 – finance officer). QuickBooks Online (\$31.86). Star Quality Construction (\$434.00 – Snow Removal for February). SD Dept of Health Water Testing (\$20.00). US Bank (\$771.26 – Quarterly Water Improvement Loan Payment).

A motion was made by Lesnar to approve the warrants and this was seconded by Rudningen.

There was one building permit issued this month to Dave Koslowski. An update on the water main break was given by Herrick. He stated that time was spent trying to find specific turn-offs for the affected area; none were found. Since the shut-offs were not available, the entire town's water was shut off by WEB water to repair the water line. The post office had a sewer line issue and while this was being repaired the contractor suggested that the post office put in a septic tank of its own instead of trying to recouple the line to the Longbranch septic tank. The post office will let the town know what the owner has decided. The Town Wide Clean-Up will be held May 1st thru May 15th. Nuisance Complaint about a person trespassing and acting erratically has been tabled until the April meeting.

Public Open Forum: A resident questioned paying board members for time spent trying to find water shut-offs and supervising the water main repair. The board let this resident know that it was a training opportunity for board members. Gerald Lesnar wanted to thank Star Quality Construction for an excellent job with the snow removal this past winter.

A motion was made by Herrick to adjourn the meeting and seconded by Lesnar.
